

Once in Cozumel, there are lots of places within walking-distance, or you can take a cab, rent a car, or even a scooter.

What's happening at Chester Zoo.

The little dik-dik making a big impression: Keepers step in to hand-rear orphaned baby antelope at Chester Zoo

- Tiny dik-dik being cared for by zoo staff after mum passed away soon after giving birth
- Newborn antelope stands at just 19-centimetres tall
- Little youngster is no bigger than a bottle of pop and too light to register a weight on the zoo's scales
- The species is named after the sound it makes when threatened

Keepers at Chester Zoo have stepped in to raise a young antelope.

The tiny Kirk's dik-dik is being bottle fed by staff five times a day following the sad death of its mum, who passed away not long after giving birth to the now 19-centimetre tall youngster.

He will be given a helping hand until he is old enough to eat by himself.

Assistant team manager Kim Wood and keeper Barbara Dreyer have both been playing 'mum' to the new arrival, who has been named Thanos. He is currently so light he doesn't register a weight on the zoo's set of antelope scales.

Kim said: "The youngster is beginning to find his feet now and is really starting to hold his own. He is doing ever so well and is getting stronger by the day. We're hopeful that, in a few months' time,



we'll be able to introduce him to some of the other members of our group of dik-diks.

"He may be tiny but he is certainly making a big impression on everyone at the zoo."

Kirk's dik-diks grow to a maximum size of just 40cm, making them one of the smallest species of antelope in the world.













OUR LATEST NEWS & EVENTS

The species takes its name from Sir John Kirk, a 19th century Scottish naturalist, as well as the sound it makes when fleeing from danger.

Kirk's dik-diks are native to North East Africa and conservationists say they mark their territory with fluid from glands between their toes and just under their eyes, not dissimilar to tears.



AutoReview by Tony Yates



I'm going to be honest here -I am not a big Porsche fan

 but the 911 Turbo is a fantastic car. So first off - here are some stats: inside you will find a 3.8 litre twin turbo horizontally opposed engine that sits at the rear and produces 397 kW (540 hp) and a maximum torque of 710 Nm. 0 to 62 mph comes up in 3.0 seconds (with launch control) and a on a race track you will reach a max top speed of 198 mph.

Now I have your full attention I will begin;

Design:

The new 911 Turbo is one of the best looking in the range and it has this ability to appeal to a person's heart as well as their heads. I said I was not a Porsche fan - but if I am honest. I can't stop looking at it because it is such a stunning looking machine that's extraordinary in every way.

Yes the 911 has been around as long as the beginning of time - but then Porsche have an ability to take a design that let's face it, has had many incarnations over many years - and then refine it until they end up offering you something that is simply staggering.

At the front you will find an all new front section which has the addition of LED headlights and 4 point daytime running lights as standard specification on all models. Then, at the rear you will find the elegantly designed three dimensional taillights and the powerfully shaped twin tailpipes that you tend to find nailed to the back of NASA Rocket.

On the inside:

The interior is just as dynamic as the exterior. Sitting inside a modern Porsche is just as good as it has always been.

This is a driver focused car - everything is in the right place and placed perfectly at the drivers fingertips. Nothing for me in here is out of place or fussy.

As standard the Turbo also comes with plenty of equipment, including dual-zone climate, heated windscreen washer jets, electric sports seats and a media system that features integrated sat-nay, USB, Internet functions and a whole host of things to keep you happy for hours if not weeks.

Chassis:

The chassis of the 911Turbo is epic – there is no other word to describe it. The smooth high speed manoeuvrability of the 911 is the icing on your auntie's sponge cake when it comes to having a lot of fun with a car that basically has a

very large engine hanging out the back. Also, being a 911 it has exceptional levels of stability and cornering agility thanks to those Porsche engineers and those large 20 inch wheels which all help in playing their part in keeping the 911 firmly planted onto the tarmac.


Also, remember 540bhp should not be dismissed – because at times it can be a little scary – especially because of the way the 911 Turbo gets you from standstill to Defcon1.

To sum up:

Everything about the 911 Turbo is perfection and I for one am missing it terribly right now.



Gardening (1)

If April means spring to you, get out your garden tools and get moving. As always, we're slaves to the whims of nature. It always seems spring drags its heels and then runs full force into summer. Be prepared with an organized "To Do" list and take advantage of whatever nice days we are afforded. Our plants will still need pruning, feeding and weeding even if the sun doesn't always shine.



Here's a Garden-To-Do List for the springy month of April:

Kill weeds

Getting on top of weeds early in the season means that you should prevent them seeding and becoming a problem. Hoeing the border once a week works well. Perennial weeds, such as dandelions, will come back if they're hoed off, so to get rid of them permanently use a weedkiller containing glyphosate.

Get your lawn in shape

After a winter of neglect, your lawn will benefit from a bit of TLC now. Start mowing once a week, beginning with the blades at the highest setting and gradually lowering them over the weeks. If your lawn mower needs replacing, see our Best Buy lawn mowers. For a perfect finish, trim the lawn's edges with long-handled shears or a grass trimmer. Bare or thin patches of grass can be thickened up by raking over the surface and then resowing. Lastly, give the lawn a feed. If it contains weeds or moss, treat these at the same time with a weed, feed and mosskiller treatment.

Plant out sweet peas

After pinching out sweet peas last month, they should have strong side-shoots that will flower well. Plant them next to a support that they can climb by wrapping their tendrils around; they'll need to be tied in with string at the start to get them going.

Harvest salads

Early sowings of salads should be ready to pick now. Cut off the leaves, rather than pulling up the whole plant, and they should resprout new ones. Sow a pinch of seeds every few weeks to have a succession of leaves to harvest through the spring and summer. Good salads to try include loose-leaf lettuce, rocket, mizuna and mustard.

Looking after your lawn

- If you haven't already aerated your lawn, there's still time to do it. You can use either a lawn aerator or simply insert a garden fork at regular intervals and lean it back slightly to let air in.
- Continue to clear fallen leaves off the lawn to keep it healthy.
- Remember to set your lawn mower to a higher cut-height to start with.
- Now your beds are clear, try edging your lawn. Lawn edging creates a neat and tidy appearance and makes maintenance easier.
- Try gathering your leaves on to the lawn and mow them with a rotary mower that has a collection box on the back. They will rot down quicker in your compost bins.

With the news full of NHS statistics I thought I would share some with you. Another busy week here at The Countess in which 1464 people were seen in A&E. 1703 people went home, 6059 people attended outpatients, 534 people had operations, 700 people had x rays and 60 babies were born!

As you may be aware, our Charity exists not to fund patient care, but to enhance and improve it by providing grants for projects that are over and above those provided by core NHS funding.

Any help and support The Countess Charity can give to support patient care is always appreciated by our clinical colleagues. The Babygrow Appeal has been our main project over the past few years with a target of £2.4 million. This appeal is now nearly at an end and the project is now at the planning stage.

Over the next 12 months we want to provide patients with a new Breast Ultra Sound Scanner to replace one funded by the charity, 80 scans are taken in an average week on women and men. The scanner costs £120k, so we are planning to fundraise to purchase the scanner in

We will be promoting Breast Care as a part of this process and clinical colleagues have asked that we also promote this aspect to men as well. We would provide the support, publicity. enthusiasm and the expertise of a professional and committed fundraising team experienced in the organisation of Balls, Lunches, Golf Days, sponsored events and lots of staff fundraising. Working together with our partners for a mutually beneficial relationship.


