

What's happening at Chester Zoo.

Rare monkey born at Chester Zoo

- Zookeepers have released the first pictures of a new baby Sulawesi crested macaque
- Tiny youngster, named Amidala, has been born to mum Lisa and dad Mamassa
- The critically endangered species is one of the world's most threatened primates with just 5,000 estimated to remain
- Chester Zoo conservationists are working with local communities in Sulawesi to help protect forests and the species living in them

A rare baby Sulawesi crested macaque is gently cradled by her mum Lisa at Chester Zoo.

A rare baby Sulawesi crested macaque has been born at Chester Zoo to mum Lisa and dad Mamassa.

The tiny female youngster, which keepers have named Amidala, is a welcome boost to the European endangered species breeding programme that is working to protect the charismatic monkeys; listed as critically endangered by the International Union for the Conservation of Nature (IUCN).

The illegal wildlife trade and large scale habitat



loss - due to illegal logging on its native island of Sulawesi in Indonesia - has pushed the Sulawesi macaque to the edge of extinction, with fewer than 5,000 now estimated to remain. They are also targets for poachers and are over-hunted for food as, in their homeland, they are considered a local delicacy and are served up on special occasions such as weddings. The species' wild number is

believed to have plummeted by around 80% in the last 30 years.

The new arrival at the zoo increases the number of Sulawesi crested macaques living in its Islands habitat to 18 - including four offspring for new dad Mamassa who, according to staff, has "become an instant hit

with the females" since his arrival in late 2015.

Conservationists from Chester are also working with the local communities in Sulawesi to help protect forests and the diverse animal species living in them.







Autoreview by Tony Yates

Keeping you motoring

Range Rover Evoque HSE Dynamic



We all know that the original Range Rover is the best 4x4 on the market and it has been this way for many years – but as a motoring journalist - this does tend to cause me a bit of a problem every time I test a newer version of this incredible machine – because, I always end up writing the same final sentence that I did when I tested the previous model. – Which is; 'The Range Rover is utterly brilliant in every single way'.

Now, I know you won't all agree - because over the last few years, we have been constantly banging on about saving the planet so much that suddenly everybody is wanting something a little bit smaller and that little bit more economical.

So, for all you people who don't want a full size Range Rover, but instead want something a little bit smaller, then you are in luck – because this week I just happen to be testing the Evoque HSE Dynamic.

Power and Efficiency

My test car was fitted with a brilliant 180HP - 2.0LTD4 diesel engine and a 9-speed automatic transmission along with 430Nm of torque which is more than enough grunt to pretty much pull anything that takes your fancy. Fuel consumption is also good achieving around 49mpg. Flat out you can expect to achieve a max speed of 121mph and a 0-62 time of around 9.7sec. For those of you who are all about emissions – the Evoque easily comes in at around 149g/km, which will also help you save a few more pennies in road tax charges.

On & Off-Road

The Evoque does off-road brilliantly! No matter how rubbish you are on the muddy stuff; it just keeps going. All you really have to do is arrive at a muddy field – press a few buttons and off you go, it really is that simple. It's the same when you have the Evoque on the tarmac too.

On the road, the Evoque is a peach to drive, there is plenty of feedback through the wheel, and with those 20" wheels - it's glued firmly to the road without impacting on ride comfort or overall refinement. Like I said - it's just plain brilliant.

Safety and Technology

The Evoque HSE also comes with a host of significantly enhanced features including; Xenon headlamps, heated windscreen, rain-sensing windscreen wipers, front and rear parking sensors, In Control Touch Navigation with 10.2-inch touchscreen, DAB radio, Meridian 10-speaker sound system, lane departure

warning, rear view camera, Airbags – side curtain, driver and front passenger, Plus; Autonomous Emergency Braking, Terrain Response, Hill Descent Control and Dynamic Stability Control.



With the news full of NHS statistics I thought I would share some with you. Another busy week here at The Countess in which 1464 people were seen in A&E, 1703 people went home, 6059 people attended outpatients, 534 people had operations, 700 people had x rays and 60 babies were born!

As you may be aware, our Charity exists not to fund patient care, but to enhance and improve it by providing grants for projects that are over and above those provided by core NHS funding.

Any help and support The Countess Charity can give to support patient care is always appreciated by our clinical colleagues. The Babygrow Appeal has been our main project over the past few years with a target of £2.4 million. This appeal is now nearly at an end and the project is now at the planning stage.

Over the next 12 months we want to provide patients with a new Breast Ultra Sound Scanner to replace one funded by the charity, 80 scans are taken in an average week on women and men. The scanner costs £120k, so we are planning to fundraise to purchase the scanner in

a 16 month timescale. We are approaching local shops, companies and businesses with the hope they will select this project with The Countess Charity as their nominated charity for 2017/18.

We will be promoting Breast Care as a part of this process and clinical colleagues have asked that we also promote this aspect to men as well. We would provide the support, publicity, enthusiasm and the expertise of a professional and committed fundraising team experienced in the organisation of Balls, Lunches, Golf Days, sponsored events and lots of staff fundraising. Working together with our partners for a mutually beneficial relationship.
