

What's happening at Chester Zoo.

Rare baby giraffe makes adorable outdoor debut

- Rare Rothschild's giraffe calf takes his first steps outside
- Keepers name one week old calf 'Narus' after a valley in Uganda where zoo conservationists are fighting to save the species
- Rothschild's giraffe are one of the world's most endangered mammals
- Less than 1,600 now remain in the wild
- Narus has become an online sensation - more than 20 million people have watched the moment he fell 6ft during birth

Walking tall! One-week-old giraffe calf, Narus, takes his first adorable steps outside with the herd at Chester Zoo.

A rare one-week-old giraffe calf has made his first outdoor appearance at Chester Zoo.

The 6ft-tall youngster, Narus, took his first tentative steps outside under the watchful eye mum, Orla, and the rest of the giraffe herd.

The adorable moment was captured on film by staff at the zoo.

Zookeepers have named their new arrival Narus after a valley in Kidepo National Park, Uganda, where the zoo's conservationists are working to protect one of the last remaining populations of Rothschild's giraffe.



Tim Rowlands, curator of mammals at the zoo, said: "Giraffe calves get to their feet within minutes of birth, but those long legs can still take a bit of getting used to. He has settled in really well and after his little adventure outside he seems to have come on leaps and bounds.

"Narus was only born last week and already

more than 20million people have watched the footage of his birth online, so it's great that he has been able to raise such huge awareness of his species — which is experiencing a silent extinction in the wild."

The International Union for the Conservation of Nature has listed all giraffe species as vulnerable to extinction in the wild. Rothschild's giraffes are one of the most threatened and it's estimated that only 1,600 remain — as poaching and habitat loss across Africa threatening their future.

Chester Zoo is part of ongoing projects in both Uganda and South Africa which are working to protect giraffes in the wild.

Rothschild's giraffe facts:

- Rothschild's giraffe calf Narus was born on Monday 3 April 2017.
- Mum Orla is eight years old (born 17/03/2008)
 She has previously given birth to two other calves at Chester Zoo, Millie and Kidepo
- Dad Meru is seven years old (born 03/04/2010)
- Rothschild's giraffes are one of the most endangered of the nine sub-species of giraffe
- They are named after zoologist Lord Walter Rothschild, founder of the National History Museum in Tring, Hertfordshire
- The species is identified by its broader dividing white lines and has no spots beneath the knees
- Once wide-ranging across Kenya, Uganda and Sudan, the Rothschild's giraffe has been almost totally eliminated from much of its former range and now only survives in a few small, isolated populations in Kenya and Uganda
- Estimates suggest that less than 1,600 Rothschild's giraffes remain in the wild

- Roughly one-third of the surviving population of Rothschild's giraffes live in zoos where carefully co-ordinated breeding programmes are creating a safety-net population for the species
- The main threat to the species now is loss of habitat and poaching for meat and hides
- In the past, giraffes were hunted for their tails, which were used as good-luck charms, sewing thread and even fly swats
- Predators to the Rothschild's giraffe include hyenas, lions, crocodiles and leopards.

The brand new £37m theatre, cinema and library in Chester



Storyhouse opened its doors for the first-time on 11 May with the inaugural home-produced season including a brand-new version of The Beggar's Opera, Alice in Wonderland, and Shakespeare's A Midsummer Night's Dream and Julius Caesar. All four productions will be performed in rep by a company of 26 actors - the largest rep company in the UK outside of the RSC and

Storyhouse is a new public attraction - a theatre, library and cinema, home to a year-round programme of home-made and touring theatre, film along with a host of activities across its considerable public spaces.

Designed by Bennetts Associates and featuring an 800/500 seat-theatre; a 100-seat cinema; a 150-seat flexible studio theatre; library spaces; digital production and broadcast facilities; a café bar and restaurant. Storyhouse is carved from the Grade II listed art deco 1936 Odeon cinema and a brand-new state of the art glass extension. Storyhouse is predicted to receive 600,000 visits per year, it brings cinema and theatre back to Chester city centre after a decade long absence. Cheshire West and Chester council has committed an inspirational £32.5 million to fund the creation of Storyhouse.

Storyhouse's £37m build cost has been made possible by an inspiring investment from Cheshire West and Chester Council, with generous support from Arts Council England and major local employer MBNA. Funding has also been attracted from major national trusts and foundations. A Seat Appeal and public campaign will allow local audiences to contribute, however large or small, and feel personally invested in Storyhouse. In June 2016 Storyhouse received its first revenue funding - a multi-year 6-figure donation from Manchester-based Oglesby Charitable Trust to kickstart a major element of the community programme. Julius Caesar has been kindly supported by Megan Gwynne-Jones Charitable Trust. The programme this Autumn includes musicals, international drama, stand-up comedy, dance and opera. Storyhouse brings a permanent theatre back to Chester after a decade long absence.

Dance lovers finally have a reason to travel to Chester as the acclaimed all male dance company BalletBoyz perform their new show on 30 October. The sound of Buenos Aires comes to Chester on 18 October with the hit show Tangomotion, featuring world-class tango dancers and live music from the acclaimed quartet Tango Siempre.

Comedians coming to Chester's newest venue in the autumn will include Stewart Lee (BBC 2's Comedy Vehicle) with his new show Content Provider and 8 of 10 Cats does Countdown regular Jon Richardson, on 3 October and 19 September respectively.

Artistic Director of Storyhouse, Alex Clifton said 'We are delighted with the range of our opening touring season. This is a programme that tells stories in so many guises: through dance, music, comedy and drama. We are thrilled to be welcoming some of the country's leading producers and after so many years without a theatre. Chester is once again at the centre of great culture. To provide a home for these wonderful shows that all pack an emotional punch, and to open our doors to audiences of all ages and tastes is exactly the reason we're here. See you soon at Storyhouse!"



You will jet off to the new airport at Brindisi for 3 days, which has been known as the "Gateway to the East" since ancient times, when it became an important port, first for the Roman troops, and later for the merchants of Venice. This port in Apulia even today provides important travel connections to and from a long list of sea and airports.

The shoreline is low and sandy for the whole stretch of coast, favoured by a mild climate. Charming vacation destinations, along with one of the major natural areas of the region, attract tourism to Brindisi's coastal strip, with many important traces left from ancient times. A must to visit whilst here is Trulli. The trulli, limestone dwellings found in the southern region of Puglia, are remarkable examples of drywall (mortarless) construction, a prehistoric building technique still in use in this region. The trulli are made of roughly worked limestone boulders collected from neighbouring fields. Characteristically. thev feature pyramidal, domed or conical roofs built up of corbelled limestone slabs. Each Trulli house offers wroughtiron beds, antique furniture, living area with a kitchenette.

Another visit is the island of Santorini which makes up part of Greece's Cyclades. This volcanic island has been known for its incredible natural beauty and cityscape and hosts more than a dozen villages and towns, some clinging to the caldera of the volcano. Taking a flight from Athens to Santorini Airport allows for a quicker means of arrival as well as one that avoids sea sickness.

In Santorini, the sites are pretty much anything you can set your eyes on. The island has ranked high as a top destination for weddings, catching the sunset, and simple peace. The most captivating towns would include Fira, Ia, and Thirasis as they cling to steep cliffs and face the caldera bay. Those looking to catch the sunset head to la as it provides the most ideal position and doesn't lose the sun behind the volcano. Competing with la and its whitewashed walls and blue domes is the village of Pyrgos which is the highest point of the island. The center of the island is where the town of Mesaria is with the Argiros Estate, and the church of St. Ann is located in the small rock village of Vothonas. The countryside is excellent for exploration through some of the world's most beautiful scenery.

Your last 3 day stay will be in Venice. The Grand Canal is the main street of Venice. Lined with beautiful, if aging, palazzo, you can hop aboard a gondola and imagine a time when these boats were the main means of transport (once there was 10,000 now there are 400). The impressive palazzo, homes to all the wealthy had highly decorated families, exteriors with colorful paintings and mosaics. These days they tend to have faded to one color but many still have the ornate, oriental facades influenced by the merchant trading with the East which made Venice rich.

Places you will visit on this holiday include Brindisi for 3 days, then Katakolon, Santorini, Piraeus, Corfu, Kotor and fianlly Venice for 3 days. Enjoy!





Keeping you motoring

Ford Fiesta ST200



Ford Fiesta ST200 - a Tweaked ST. but still fun to drive in any version.

As a child I used to spend most of my weekends watching Bodie & Doyle strut their stuff on TV, whilst also watching them messing about doing handbrake turns and smoking the tyres around the streets of London in a selection of cars from the likes of British Levland and Ford to name but a few.

Of course as you get older - reality slips in and you realise it was all fake and just for the purpose of TV entertainment - but as a young boy, it didn't stop me spending many hours in my garden acting out scenes from the latest episode where I was the good guy in my Ford Fiesta XR2 chasing the baddies.

Even now 30 years on, Ford's ST200 has started to ignite all my senses and prove once again why Ford continues to dominate the 'Hot Hatch' arena.

Power and Efficiency

Powered by an 1.6 litre Eco Boost turbocharged petrol engine with 290Nm of Torque - 200PS of Ford Power, a 0-62 time of around 6.7 seconds and a top speed of around142mph.

I also expected the little Fiesta to sound a little wheezy - but to be honest - I was wrong about that too. Because instead what you do get is something that sounds like the Knights Templars are having their own conquest right under your seat. Take it from me; it really is the most wonderful noise you can hear bellowing from that Eco Boost engine.

On the Road

As with all of Ford's hot hatches – it changes direction like it's on rails and it holds the road like a F1 car on super sticky slicks. Don't get me wrong, it does have its faults. But when it comes down to getting it on – nothing on the road as small as the ST200 can even get close to how it handles on the twisty stuff.

Plus, Ford has also stiffened up the suspension and updated the front anti-roll bar, meaning the ST200 now feels more solid than a standard ST - which also helps improve the ride without the need for back surgery every few weeks.

Safety and Technology

On the inside you get Recaro seating and branded ST interior details – but I found the Sat-Nav/Radio far too complex. I am not joking either – I actually think it's more complex than a Rubik's Cube. But then again I am not that tech savvy – so maybe I need to take in some training or read the handbook.

Also, as its the ST200 you also get a lot of additional features such as; cruise control, privacy glass, Thatcham Cat1 alarm, full ST bodystyling kit, unique ST200 badges, rain sensing wipers, auto headlights, puddle lamps, Mykey technology, 17" matt black alloys, Sony DAB radio, and a whole host of sophisticated systems including Electronic Torque Vectoring Control.

To Sum Up

Epic – but, I would buy the standard Fiesta ST – unless the ST200 really is your dream car.

Summer - the time for recreation and holidays. But before you leave for your summer holidays, we have a couple of tips on what to do in your midsummer garden.

CUTTING STRONG GROWING HEDGES

To make sure that hedges grow densely and evenly, they should be cut several times a year. After the main breeding period of birds from March to late July, you can start cutting your hedges again.

SHAPE YOUR BOXWOODS

To preserve the details of boxwood trees or bushes which were cut in shape, you should now cut back your boxwoods and other evergreens. For perfect shapes you can create templates from cardboard.

PRUNING LAVENDER

When lavender has mostly finished flowering, the shoots should be reduced approximately by one third. This prevents the lavender plants from investing too much energy into seed production. The following year, your lavender will be back with a strong bloom.

REMOVE DEAD FLOWERS

Removing wilted flowers is not only done for aesthetic reasons, but also supports the formation of new flowering shoots. The plant can concentrate its power to the fresh flowers. Moreover, the dead flowers will not become a breeding ground for pests or fungi. Some summer shrubs like larkspur, produce flowers a second time in autumn, when they are cut back after the main flowering.

FIRST AID FOR SUNFLOWERS

If your sunflowers did not come through the latest summer storm, the final chapter has not yet been written. With first aid for sunflowers, you can save even turned down stems. Put the fracture in a splint made of bamboo sticks and fix it with duct tape. This way the water supply is guaranteed.



SOW FRESH SEEDS ON VACATED PATCHES

In August the gardening year is almost over. Some vegetables, however, can still be sown without any problems at the now-vacated patches. These include Radishes, Lettuce, Rocket, Winter Onions and Spinach.



DIVIDE SHRUBS

Should the flowering of your shrubs get weaker or should the blossoms get bald inside, it's time to give your summer shrubs a rejuvenating cure by dividing them. August is a good month for dividing spring and summer flowering shrubs. Dig the shrubs out with a spade or a fork and divide the plants into parts. The single parts should be at least as big as a fist. Remove sick and withered root parts as well as bald spots. Planted at suitable locations the shrubs will return in full blossom.

Please help our son Tobias

My 6-month-old son, Tobias has infantile fibrosarcoma, an extremely rare form of childhood cancer.

Tobias was born on 28th September 2016. At his 8 week check the GP found an abdominal lump in his stomach and he was admitted to hospital. After a lot of tests he was diagnosed with infantile flbrosarcoma. The cancer is so rare that over the last 20 years, only 50 children in Europe have been diagnosed with it.

Doctors at Manchester's Royal Manchester Children's Hospital removed the tumour in his abdomen, and Tobias then underwent "light" chemotherapy to destroy the tumour in his spine that it wasn't possible to safely resect.

But by the second round of chemotherapy Tobias was suffering from severe sickness. The doctors gave him an ultrasound which showed another large tumor that had grown during treatment - making what was already an incredibly rare situation even more complicated, as infantile fibrosarcoma usually responds very well to chemotherapy. Tobias had to undergo surgery again, to remove the larger tumour, and also two tumours more that were found during the process.


Tobias has now started a course of much stronger chemotherapy. But as his situation is so rare, there is no protocol for which chemotherapy to use. It is also very rare for chemotherapy this strong to be used on a baby so young. Tobias's consultant has said that if this round of chemotherapy doesn't work, then his only options are radical surgery with removal of organs, or radiotherapy, both of which would likely be only palliative.

My family and I (who are from the Wirral) have found a trial of immunotherapy which directly targets the gene fusion involved with his cancer if the worst happens and his tumour grows back again. Unfortunately, although the drug company LOXO would fund expenses and the drug, medical costs would not be covered. In the US version of the trial, we've been told those costs could "easily" run into the range of hundreds of thousands of pounds - far out of my family's reach. We are trying to fundraise for this treatment. Our son has never known anything but this hell, and he deserves a chance at life.

In the case that Tobias doesn't need the money, we would donate it either to children's cancer charities that fund research into treatments for childhood cancer, or to other parents at RMCH who need to take their sick child abroad for freatment. Treatment for childhood cancer is severely underfunded, leaving children like Tobias with very few options.
