





What's happening at Chester Zoo.

Adorable baby giraffe enjoys his first outdoor adventure at Chester Zoo



 New arrival is special addition to endangered species breeding programme for 'one of Africa's most at risk species'

- Fewer than 2,650 Rothschild's giraffes remain in the wild
- Zoo conservationists are working to boost numbers of remaining populations in Uganda

A two-week-old giraffe calf, named Mburo, struts his stuff as he steps outside for the very first time at Chester Zoo

A two-week-old giraffe calf has stepped outside for the very first time at Chester Zoo.

The six-foot-tall newcomer held his head high as he made his first public appearance, venturing out with the rest of the herd including parents Dagmar and Meru.

The birth of the calf was captured by the zoo's CCTV on Tuesday 5 March and the calf spent the first few weeks of his life indoors as he spent time forging important close bonds with his mum.

Zookeepers have named the new arrival 'Mburo' after an area of western Uganda which the zoo's field conservation partners, The Giraffe Conservation Foundation, first translocated a group of Rothschild's giraffes to - a vital conservation move to boost then dwindling giraffe numbers.

Sarah Roffe, Giraffes Team Manager at the zoo, said:

"Since being born just two weeks ago, Mburo has been spending lots of quality time with mum Dagmar and the rest of the herd. Now he's really found his feet and his confidence is coming on leaps and bounds – his little personality is really starting to shine through.

"To see a young Rothschild's giraffe calf strutting his stuff is really quite special – a real privilege when you consider that fewer than 2,650 remain in the wild. For many years they have been experiencing a silent extinction and it's important that we help raise awareness of their plight and continue to help boost numbers in the international breeding programme, as well as assist with conservation efforts in Africa."

Rothschild's giraffes are one of the world's most at-risk mammals but recent news from Africa offers hope. It has been revealed that numbers are slowly increasing in Kidepo Valley and Murchison Falls National Parks.

Sarah added:

"Whilst it's incredibly positive news that numbers in the wild are slowly increasing, the tiny Rothschild's giraffe populations in the wild are extremely fragile and must be carefully monitored to ensure their continued survival. Our experts have worked in Kidepo Valley National Park in Uganda for a number of years helping to protect, monitor and track the population – so it's an incredible feeling to know we've played an essential role in the beginning of their recovery."

Conservationists at Chester are working with partners The Giraffe Conservation Foundation (GCF) and the Uganda Wildlife Foundation (UWA) to protect the last remaining wild populations of Rothchild's giraffes in Africa.

The city is located in the centralwestern portion of the Italian Peninsula, within Lazio (Latium), along the shores of Tiber river. The Vatican City is an independent country geographically located within the city boundaries of Rome, the only existing example of a country within a city: for this reason Rome has been often defined as capital of two states. Monuments and museums such as the Vatican Museums and the Colosseum are among the world's most visited tourist destinations with both locations receiving millions of tourists a year. Rome also hosted the 1960 Summer Olympics.

Rome has earned its ancient nickname of The Eternal City - no matter how many places in Italy vie for our attention, there's no city that can compare to Rome. Here you can walk the same streets that Caesar once walked, set foot in the smallest independent nation on earth, and see the handiwork of some of the world's greatest artists. Then you can turn a corner to see how modern Romans live alongside all that historic splendor.

Stroll through the one-time epicenter of the Roman Empire, gaze over the largest Roman amphitheater, see the Pope give his weekly address in St. Peter's Square, test your resolve at the Mouth of Truth, learn to fight like a gladiator, and find out what makes Roman pizza different from the stuff you'll eat in Naples. Few cities can entertain and overwhelm as quickly as Rome, so plan to take your time - and take plenty of breaks to sample the city's famous coffee and gelato. And don't forget to throw a coin in the Trevi Fountain to make sure you get

a return trip to this most fascinating of cities.

You will then sail away to visit **Marseille** which is the second largest city in France after Paris.

Marseille was historically the most important trade centre in the region and functioned as the main trade port of the French Empire. Marseille is France's largest city on the Mediterranean coast and largest commercial port as well as a leading cruise and freight port.

You will then sail away to visit Barcelona, repare to be wowed by the creative genius of Gaudí, take time out along the stunning harbour, and get to know these sandy shorelines by the shimmering Mediterranean. Bars, beaches, boutiques and more...

You again set sail for the beautiful island of Mallorca one of Spain's Balearic Islands in the Mediterranean. It's known for beach resorts, sheltered coves, limestone mountains and Roman and Moorish remains. Capital Palma has nightlife, the Moorish Almudaina royal palace and 13th-century Santa Maria Cathedral.

Going the Distance - 480 Years of Racing at the Roodee A new exhibition to launch at the Chester Grosvenor Museum



Once likened to racing on 'green velvet' by jockey Lester Piggott, Chester's hallowed Roodee turf is uniquely positioned at the heart of the city of Chester. With less than 50 days to go until a new season of racing at Chester and as the racecourse celebrates another milestone in its illustrious history, a new exhibition at the Chester Grosvenor Museum will soon open to commemorate 480 years of racing at Chester.

Opening on Saturday 20 April, this exhibition will present objects and images from Chester Race Company and the Grosvenor Museum that will explore the origins and heritage of the oldest racecourse still in operation in Great Britain, if not the world.

Members of the public are invited to visit the exhibition and learn the fascinating story of the evolvement of the racecourse and its famous site which dates back to the Roman period. From archaeological excavations and racing firsts to tales of legend and stories of gallant victors, the timeline of the Roodee paints a rich tapestry that will stand the test of time.

Chief Executive Officer of Chester Race Company, Richard Thomas said,

"We have been working closely with the museum over the last 12 months in a new Corporate Partnership capacity to bring our story to the general public. Many will be aware of some of the more famous facts, faces and stories of the Roodee and we are thilled that a fascinating collective narrative of the racecourse's history will be brought to life this year to commemorate 480 years. We are proud to have built a strong relationship with the museum and celebrate our connection with the city of Chester and its people."

Running the duration of the 2019 Chester racing season, members of the public along with racegoers visiting the

city are invited to enjoy this exciting exhibition and even get involved by imparting their own mementos or memories into the narrative. The museum is interested in hearing from anyone who holds anything from race badges, programmes and photographs to hats and fascinators from the past 480 years.

Councillor Louise Gittins, Cabinet Member for Communities and Wellbeing, Cheshire West and Chester Council, said:

"Our Corporate Sponsorship Scheme started in September last year, businesses can play a vital role in developing arts and culture. The new Partnership Scheme is helping to safeguard an essential part of Chester's Heritage for current and future generations.



Keeping you motoring

Honda HR-V 1.5 i-VTEC - S



When you first see the HR-V you will start to think 'is it a coupe or an SUV'. That's exactly what I thought when It arrived on my driveway, but I have been told that Honda wanted it to have the lines of a coupe, but also the robustness of an SUV and to be honest they seem to have pulled that off rather well and now the HR-V is one of the better-looking SUV's currently on the market.

Power and Efficiency:

The 1.5 Litre i-VTEC has 130PS and 155Nm of torque which is good and all thanks to Honda doing such a wonderful job of getting the best out of this fantastic little petrol engine that is so far, this year, one of the better ones I have come across for its size. I am also happy to report that the engine feels very refined and has bags of torque available when you need it most which makes motorway driving easy, quiet and unfussy.

The HR-V will also return a combined 42.8 MPG if driven with a very light right foot - and the emissions came in at a very respectable 130 g/ km. Top speed will also stop at around 119mph and 0-62 will come in at around 10.2 seconds.

On the road:

The HR-V does not feel heavy or cumbersome at all - and you can sense that Honda has put in a lot of effort in setting up the suspension and chassis to help deal with the many different surfaces the HR-V will come across in its lifetimebe that the morning school run or that camping trip away with the family.

Design & Technology:

The interior is of a good standard and its controls are well set out and all the dials are clear. I did not like the driver's seat as I found I just couldn't get the seating position perfect for me – but then I am quite fussy. Space inside is also good – better than most, and you could easily fit in a very large amount of luggage.

Plus – everything inside the HR-V feels well put together because it's a Honda and you know it will last till the end of time. Passenger legroom is also fine, as is the boot space with a seat up capacity of (431 litres) and seats folded flat capacity of (1456 litres).

Standard equipment on the S model includes; LED daytime running lights, Honda Connect with Garmin navigation, parking sensors, heated seats, LED headlights, smart keyless entry & start, rearview camera, brake assist, DAB radio with USB and Bluetooth connectivity, automatic climate control and cruise control with speed limiter The list does not stop there either – you also get; magic seats, power windows, ISO fix points, alarm & immobilizer system, hill start assist and vehicle stability assist.

To sum up:

A good buy – If you are searching for one of the best looking compact SUV's currently on the market with the addition of some good specification even in basic trim - and enough space to keep any large family happy, then the HR-V could be the perfect fit for you.

We're well into late spring now, with the worst of the weather behind us, we hope! Members of Chester Rambling and Hill Walking Club have been avidly browsing through our newly issued Summer programme to see what's planned during our Centenary year. Looking ahead, we have long hikes in the hills of Cheshire, Shropshire and North Wales to look forward to, as well as camping trips further afield. The shorter Tuesday evening walks start in early May too - a delightful way to end a summer's day.

Most programmes feature some new walk leaders, who have been with the Club a year or more and decide they'd like to try out life at the forefront. Sometimes, rather than aging it alone. new leaders team up and plan a route together, pooling their knowledge and ideas and reconnoitring their walk a few times so that they are confident on the day. One recent spring walk was led by two new leaders who took us on a fairly local 8-mile route in the Delamere Forest region, starting from the public car park at The Yeld in Kelsall. This area offers lots of footpaths heading in all directions, whether along the Sandstone Trail, into the Forest itself, or onto the gentle slopes of Primrose and Eddisbury Hills. The route chosen was a well-planned and varied one, through woods, across fields and hillsides, and included the contrasting Iron Age hill forts at Eddisbury and Kelsborrow, as well as a section of the former Roman road known as Watling Street, which once linked Chester (Deva) and Manchester (Mancunium).

We headed first into Nettleford Wood, before taking a path northwards towards Eddisbury Hill. At the summit there is a viewing platform with a pillar of red Cheshire sandstone. surrounded by six standing stones representing the neighbouring counties visible from here on the clearest of days: Staffordshire. Derbyshire, Lancashire, Shropshire, Denbighshire and Flintshire. Given that the weather on the day we visited was dry and sunny. the views from the top of Eddisbury Hill were quite spectacular. though Liverpool, Winter Hill and the Pennines were beyond our scope of vision. Further on, we found ourselves walking along the embankments of Eddisbury Hill Fort itself, the largest and probably the most impressive of Cheshire's Iron Age hill forts. From here, we descended and walked onwards to the woods at Primrose Hill. A popular spot, these woodlands offer numerous opportunities for the intrepid explorer, including what must be Cheshire's only true gorge, at Urchin's Kitchen. Leaving the woods, our designated route followed the Sandstone Trail, taking us towards the lovely little valley at Boothsdale, before ascending Kelsborrow Hill. Turn back just before passing through the gate above the valley, and you'll be rewarded with a spectacular view across Cheshire's green and lush lands, to the hills of Shropshire in the far distance. Wonderful!

Moving on, and we emerged alongside what is marked on the OS map as Kelsborrow Hill Fort. Unlike its nearest Iron Age neighbour, there's very little visible evidence of this ancient settlement, so an information board helpfully explains how the site would have looked in times past. Another mile or so of walking took us back through the woods to our starting point at The Yeld. We'd had a delightful day in the sunshine with a great group of people and, unusually, hadn't had to cross a single stile! Our new leaders had done a sterling job on all fronts and are hopefully undaunted at the prospect of planning other walks in the future....

The Club will shortly be celebrating its Centenary, so we're clearly doing things right. Times may have changed since we were formed in 1919, but we're confident we'll be around for many more years yet. Why not join us?


