

Local Trust launches revolutionary technology for diabetic patients

Local Trust launches revolutionary technology for diabetic patients.

Staff and local partners from local health trust CWP came together recently to formally launch an innovative new technology that aims to revolutionise the way diabetic foot ulcers are treated.

According to statistics, 4 in 10 people who develop a diabetic foot and foot-related issues. It does this by taking a digitised scan, displaying the contours of the foot. It then develops a bespoke insole for that person to use with their footwear. The project currently targets diabetic patients with pressure points and aims to reduce the number of diabetic foot ulcers developing.

saying that it had improved their quality of life.

One patient remarked: "I can now go for days out walking without having to worry about my feet getting fatigued or ulcerating - I'm over the moon!"

CWP associate director of operations for neighbourhoods and integrated care, Karen Moore, attended the launch event and participated in a demonstration of the scanner.

She said: "I was absolutely thrilled to attend this interesting and informative event. It was a great opportunity to showcase all of the excellent care that our Podiatry service provides. From my own personal point of view, I was delighted to take part in a demonstration of this new, innovative technology that the team is utilising. Having taken part, and now being in possession of my new, bespoke insoles, I can definitely see the positive impact that this will have on diabetic patients in West Cheshire."



ulcer will die within 5 years. There are also over 7000 diabetes-related amputations annually and England. Diabetic foot ulcers also precede 80% of amputations.

However, the podiatry team at Cheshire and Wirral Partnership NHS Foundation Trust (CWP) are hoping to reduce this risk by rolling out the Amfit CADCAM system.

The system has been in place for eight months, and has already seen some remarkable results. The formal launch, held at Fountains Health Centre in Chester, saw a number of Trust partners, including West Cheshire Clinical Commissioning Group and Diabetes UK, send attendees to find out more about the project, and also to see it in action.

The system uses a three dimensional scanner that will reduce the risks associated with diabetes when it comes to podiatry

Lucinda Mercer, CWP biomechanical lead and specialist podiatrist explains: "We believe that the new scanner will reduce the risk of ulceration in low, medium and high-risk patients, providing comfort and cushioning and prevent any deformities from deteriorating. We have already seen some incredibly positive outcomes for our patients since adopting the system and we are optimistic that this will continue. Our patients are at the heart of what we do, so we are always looking at ways to improve their outcomes when referred to our service."

Of the patients who have benefited so far from the system, feedback has been positive. Examples include 90% of patients saying the insoles were more comfortable than footwear alone, and 80%

With summer behind us, walk leaders in Chester Rambling and Hill Walking Club have been busy deciding which routes to submit for our winter programme, due out during October. We are fortunate that we have a pool of willing members who are happy to lead walks and share their experience of the countryside in and around our home county. A wide-ranging programme of walks at all levels is the result, and a look back at where our leaders have taken us recently bears this out. From Cheshire's tracks, trails and low undulations, to the hills of North Wales and Shropshire, and higher still to the crags of Snowdonia, we've covered lots of ground between us this summer. Along these various routes we've encountered prehistoric sites, castles, industrial heritage, stately homes, islands, lakes, rivers and waterfalls. Despite it being fairly warm for most of the season, we've seen our fair share of storms, torrential rain and dangerously gusty winds, which caused a handful of planned walks to be cancelled.

Our summer season of Tuesday night trips included old favourites like the Sandstone Trail and the low tide trek across to Hilbre Island. Informative walks are always popular and a history hike around Christleton was enjoyed one dry July evening. On the down side, a walk exploring the fascinating tales of Chester's waterways was totally rained off during June's monsoon! Just to prove that it's always prudent to have a waterproof in your rucksack, several summer walks started off in decent weather, only for the heavens to open shortly before the end. Such are the vagaries of the British climate, illustrated with great aplomb during our summer camp up by Hadrian's Wall. Thankfully, the wet weather there was countered by warm sunshine for the first and last day or two, so we did get some memorable walks along the wall under our belts.

Such walks with history are a great favourite, especially when previously unvisited sites are incorporated in a route. One such hike at Abergele passed through the grounds of Gwrych Castle, only recently reopened after years of abandonment and dereliction. A public footpath runs alongside the castle, offering fabulous close-up views of the medieval-style 'fortress'. All is not as it seems, however. The building is actually Victorian, and due to several changes in ownership over time, has seen many changes, not all for the better. Vandalism and asset-stripping have all taken their toll on this remarkable place. Fortunately, the castle was bought in 2018 by a local preservation trust, which has embarked on an ambitious renovation project to bring this iconic place back to life and open it to the public once again. My other half and I were so intrigued as we walked past with fellow Club members that we returned the following weekend, paid the modest entrance fee and had a good look behind those formidable outer walls. Whilst it's clear that restoration is a very lengthy work in progress, there is much to see and it makes a fascinating visit for anyone keen on history or taking atmospheric photographs through ancient windows....

Other historical sites encountered during this summer's walks include Capel Garmon Neolithic burial chamber near Betws-y-Coed, 13th century castles at Flint and Denbigh, and industrial heritage galore, from the 18th century Quarry Bank Mill at Styal to the disused lead mines of North East Wales. Such fascinating places add interest to already beautiful walking routes, especially those sites we've never been to before.

There's always something new to come across whilst out walking. Or something old maybe...

What's happening at Chester Zoo.

RED PANDA TWINS BORN!

Chester Zoo reveals rare cubs during first health check



- Twin red panda cubs born to mum Nima and dad Koda - are the newest additions at Chester Zoo
- Adorable duo are confirmed as one male and one female as zookeepers and vets give them their first ever once over
- Cubs are part of endangered species breeding programme
- Red panda populations have plummeted by 40% in the last 50 years, leaving them endangered in the wild
- Fewer than 10,000 survive due to deforestation, poaching for their iconic red fur and the illegal wildlife trade

Chester Zoo's newest arrivals - two adorable red panda cubs - have been revealed as a boy and a girl during their first ever health check-up.

The precious nine-week-old twins, classed by conservationists as endangered in the wild, were born on 22 June to mum Nima and dad Koda who have kept them tucked up in their nest boxes since birth.

Now, specialist vets and keepers have had their very first look at the delightful duo, examining the pair during the health check, where they were weighed, sexed and vaccinated.

Each of the fluffy youngsters was given a full, clean bill of health.

James Andrewes, Assistant Team Manager at the zoo, said:

"These red panda twins are wonderful, important new additions to the carefully managed breeding programme for the species, which is working to increase the safety-net population in Europe as numbers in the wild continue to decline.

"Happily, both cubs are developing very well indeed and the health MOTs we've been able to perform confirmed that mum Nima is clearly doing a great job of caring for them.

"We also discovered the genders of each of the cubsone male and one female - and returned them to their mum as soon as we'd finished giving them a quick once over. Nima took them straight back to her nest and it'll be a few weeks now until the cubs start to develop the confidence to come out and explore by themselves. Before they're able to stand on their own feet, it is though possible that some lucky people will have the occasional glimpse of Nima carrying them from nest to nest by the scruffs of their necks."

Red pandas are found in the mountainous regions of Nepal, India, Bhutan, Myanmar and southern China where their wild number is estimated at fewer than 10,000 – a 40% decline over

the past 50 years.

This decrease is a direct result of human actions, such as widespread habitat destruction, trapping for the illegal pet trade and poaching for their iconic red fur – which in some countries is used to make hats for newly-weds as a symbol of happy marriage.

Conservationists at Chester Zoo have called on the public help to fight the illegal wildlife trade that is driving species to extinction around the world. People can report any suspicious activity they may spot, online or on holiday, via the zoo's online illegal wildlife trade reporting form: www.chesterzoo.org/illegalwildlifetrade

In recent years, Chester Zoo has been fighting for the future of the red panda, which is also known as the 'fire fox', through habitat-focused conservation projects in the Sichuan Mountains of China, where they can be found among the bamboo forests.

A few Red Panda facts:

- At first glance red pandas look similar to racoons, having long, bushy tails, patterned with 12 alternating rich red and buff coloured rings

Tenants will be given more rights when changes to the Landlord and Tenant Act 1985 are made on 20 March 2019. People who rent will be able to sue their landlords if their homes are not up to scratch. Issues with damp, noise, ventilation, repairs, drainage, infestations and facilities for cooking are a number of the issue's tenants will be able to take action on. Gardening To Do List - October in the Garden

Gardening in October is entirely dependent on the weather. If there's an Indian Summer, there is no better time of year to be out in the garden. While gardeners in warm areas will have more to do than their northern counterparts, there are plenty of garden tasks to keep everyone busy in October.

Tidy Borders

Keep on weeding and have a gentle tidy up in your borders but do try to resist the temptation of a thorough spring clean. Leave seedheads for the birds if you don't want to collect them and as much cover as you can bear for wildlife who will appreciate the winter shelter.

Fallen leaves can be left to rot down (or collected for leaf mould), however diseased material is another matter, make it a priority to clear and burn it to prevent pests and diseases overwintering courtesy of your kind hospitality! Put the rest of your garden rubbish (apart from woody stems) in the compost.



Start your compost

If you haven't already done so, start your compost going by buying a bin or building a partially enclosed area for a heap. It is vital to replace the goodness in soil after a hefty growing season and autumn produces masses of garden waste that will put invaluable organic richness back into the ground for next spring.

Add a variety of different materials; spent vegetable and bedding plants, herbaceous leftovers, thatch, moss and cuttings from the lawn, weeds (but not the roots unless they have been through a shredder), hedge clippings, kitchen peelings and tea bags are ideal.

Prepare your soil for next year

Your soil is your most precious commodity, so start digging in compost, manure and as much organic matter as you can lay your hands on to replace the goodness in it. Healthy soil is the basis of healthy plants and a healthy environment. When garden soil is in good shape there is less need for fertilizers or pesticides.

The earlier you start the better, especially if your soil is heavy. It can be left in a pretty rough state over the winter when the elements will break the clods down, making spring planting infinitely easier! Proper pH is also an essential characteristic of healthy soil.





Rake fallen leaves

Don't waste fallen leaves (except those perilous rose leaves and evergreens, which take too long to rot down) - given time they decompose into fabulously rich leaf mould - aka 'nature's soil conditioner of choice'! Rake up fallen leaves and chuck them into a simple frame to make leaf mould (black bin liners spiked with air holes will also do if you can bear the visual offense - but remember to dampen the leaves first). If left to linger on the lawn for long, the grass will turn yellow. Leaf mould takes about a year to mature, a great top dressing for woodland plants such as rhododendrons and is an excellent and **FREE** home-grown substitute for peat.





Keeping you motoring

Kia Stinger 'GT S' - 3.3 T-GDi



This week's review is so easy. What Kia has done here is made another perfect car that has an engine more powerful than you can possibly comprehend - plus the added option of being one of the most comfortable cars I have ever had the pleasure of sitting in. The Stinger is not only good - it's utterly brilliant. And, I'm not just saying that either - it really is stunning to drive.

Power and Efficiency:

The version I currently have on test is powered by a 3.3-litre turbocharged petrol engine with 361BHP and 510Nm of torque which makes the Stinger move along like a scalded Cat - and when you consider it's quite big in size - that makes it even more that little bit special.

So, big engine means bad fuel economy right? Well actually it's not that bad at all - and you can expect to achieve around 29.4.mpg (combined) plus, an eye wobbling top speed of 168mph. Of course, speed needs to be kept on the track, but the little secret of the Stinger is that it loves the idea of doing just that. Because It wants to race, it wants to win!

On the road:

The Stinger feels very good on all roads surfaces - and there are no dramas to talk about here because it's well balanced and settled even on some of our most demanding roads - meaning you will have less to worry about if you decide to start planting the Stinger briskly into the corners. I know I have said this time and time again - but the Kia engineers really do put a lot of effort into making their cars handle well and you can feel that in the way the Stinger tells you exactly what's going on beneath you – while Kia's onboard safety features do their job by keeping everything present and correct.

Safety and Technology

Trim levels on the inside of the Stinger are also lovely and everything was bathed in leather and chrome – but for me, the Stinger is a long-distance mile muncher and a car that is able to accommodate a large family and pretty much everything you can throw at it.

The interior is also well thought out with modern hard-wearing materials that will be very good at resisting wear and tear for many years. Plus it's fitted with more safety features to keep you and your family safe – which makes me feel all warm on the inside.

With technology now being one of the most important factors most people look for when buying a new car – the Stinger needed to offer a lot of toys. Well, I can happily report that the Stinger does not fall short here – and comes with a whole array of features such as;

Council backs Chester Zoo's major Grasslands habitat



Major new Grasslands development at Chester Zoo will create African savannah habitats for a range of species including rare giraffes

- New zone designed to 'connect visitors with nature' like never before
- Expansive savannah habitat set to transport visitors to African landscape
- New restaurant to offer spectacular balcony views of giraffes, zebras and ostrich
- Grasslands habitats will be a further boost the zoo's conservation breeding work for an array of rare species
- Project will boost zoo's charitable efforts to prevent extinction of species around the world

A huge African savannah is set to be recreated at Chester Zoo after council planners backed an ambitious new development.

The project, named Grasslands, will bring together a range of different African habitats from bush land to wildlife rich plains.

The development was approved by councillors at a planning meeting, subject to final confirmation that a drainage issue has been fully resolved.

The Grasslands centrepiece - a large, open savannah - will be home to multiple rare and endangered species including Rothschild's giraffe, Grevy's zebra, ostrich and antelope, all living alongside one another.

Visitors will also come face-to-face with some of the world's smallest grassland creatures, such as naked mole rats, in a specially designed indoor habitat, celebrating the contribution of all species to the ecosystem.

Conservationists at the zoo – a globally important wildlife charity – hope the new zone will 'inspire a nation of conservationists' by connecting people with nature like never before through close-up experiences with species including cranes, vultures, aardvarks and warthogs.

A new restaurant will offer spectacular balcony views across the savannah.

The plans also include the option for the zoo to develop discreet, overnight accommodation, comprising of 42 rooms including traditional African-themed lodges, which will enable guests to wake up to a sunrise over Grasslands.



Jamie Christon, the zoo's Chief Operating Officer, said:

"Grasslands will be a phenomenal experience and will cement Chester Zoo's standing as one the world's very best attractions.

"Featuring state-of-the art conservation breeding facilities for a range of threatened African species, Grasslands will yet again see the zoo push the boundaries of world-class animal care.

"Crucially, it will bring our vital, global conservation work to life for visitors, while boosting the zoo's charitable income to further help achieve our mission to prevent extinction, here in the UK and around the world."

The new habitat will be bordered by the zoo's existing African Tsavo reserve area for critically endangered Eastern back rhino and rare African painted dogs.

It is the latest phase in the zoo's strategic development plan - a vision for the future of the zoo, creating ever more natural habitats for threatened species, divided into themed geographic regions. The existing Islands zone, which opened in 2015, was the first stage in this process, bringing the zoo's South East Asian conservation work to life for visitors to Chester.

Zoo teams will now take time to formulate the schedules associated with the creation of Grasslands, included when the building work will begin.
