

# What's happening at Chester Zoo.

## Chester becomes first UK zoo to receive prestigious accolade for its work with volunteers



The nationally important Investors in Volunteers award was given to the UK's most popular charity zoo after a 15-month-long consultation that confirmed the zoo's value and commitment to its volunteers.

The award aims to improve the quality of the volunteering experience offered by organisations all around the UK and demonstrates how the contributions made by volunteers are valued.

Volunteer Manger at Chester Zoo, Lindsay Marston, said: "As a major UK wildlife charity, the support we receive from our volunteers is invaluable. This award shows our current and future volunteers that we're committed to ensuring they have the very best experience when they volunteer with us. We're very proud to be the very first zoo in the UK to achieve this accolade."

"Our volunteers play a huge role in helping us to prevent extinction - from connecting visitors to the zoo by highlighting different species and the conservation actions we're taking to protect them, to encouraging people to think about how they too can make a positive change for wildlife. Every conversation they have plays an important part of our mission."

Typically, Chester Zoo welcomes more than 250 volunteers over the course of a year to support the charity through a range of roles. However, when the Covid-19 pandemic hit, the zoo had to change the way it engaged and supported its volunteers.

Lindsay Marston, added: "In the wake of the global pandemic we had to adapt the way we worked with volunteers and lots of our consultation work moved online. We introduced 'micro-volunteering', as it became apparent that a lot of our volunteers felt isolated and alone during lockdown. Even though we were closed, doing things like fact checking educational signage or creating spaces for wildlife at home helped them feel connected to Chester Zoo.



# SMONTHE HISTORY

This feature each month will give true interesting facts from years gone by. See what you remember that happened in your lifetime.

### THIS DAY IN HISTORY FOR THE MONTH OF JULY



#### **JULY 12th 1910**

British pilot Charles Stewart Rolls, 33, died after his French built biplane crashed at a flying competition in Bournemouth, Dorset. He was a partner in the Rolls-Royce car manufacturing company. Charles studied engineering at Railway works in Crewe, Cheshire.

In 1903, Charles established one of Britain's earliest car dealerships, in Fulham, Middlesex, to import and sell French and Belgian manufactured cars. It was to be his meeting the following year, with Henry Royce, that was decisive in creating, in partnership, the prestigious "badge"

Rolls-Royce. Two years later, in 1906, Rolls and Royce further formalised their partnership by creating Rolls Royce Limited.

#### **JULY 20th 1969**

The Eagle lands on the moon and US astronaut Neil Armstrong is the first man in history to walk on its powdery surface.

From the launch on July 16 atop a powerful Saturn rocket, Apollo 11 and its crew of three astronauts performed flawlessly. While Michael Collins orbited the Moon in the Command Module.

Armstrong piloted the Lunar Lander, named the Eagle, to a safe landing in the Moon's Sea of Tranquility. He and his copilot, Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin, soon became the first humans to tread on another world. They spent nearly 21 hours on the lunar surface, collecting samples of rock and soil and setting up remote instruments.



#### **JULY 26th 1978**

The worlds first IVF baby was born in Oldham General Hospital near Manchester. Gynecologist Patrick Steptoe and physiologist Dr Robert Edwards are credited with this pioneering work.





#### JULY 30th 1966

England win the Jules Rimet trophy, Association Football's World Cup, at Wembley Stadium in London after beating Germany 4-2 in extra time.

- Diana, Princess of Wales (1961-1997) affectionately remembered as the Queen of Hearts, mother of Princes William and Harry. Diana's activism and glamour made her an international icon and earned her enduring popularity, she will never be forgotten.

7th - Ringo Starr, (1940) drummer with the legendary Liverpool pop group The Beatles, and more significantly, the voice of Thomas the Tank Engine.

14th - Emmeline Pankhurst (1858 - 1928) Manchester born suffragette who was imprisoned in her efforts to gain the vote for British women.

28th - Beatrix Potter (1866 - 1943) author and illustrator, the characters that she created remain classics of children's literature ...Peter Rabbit, Samuel Whiskers, Squirrel Nutkin, and friends.

**30th** - Emily Brontë (1818 - 1848) novelist, one of the three Bronte sisters, her only novel Wuthering Heights tells a tale of love and revenge set in the remote wilds of her native Yorkshire.



## Thousands of schoolchildren unite in song to highlight vital environmental message

More than 13,000 schoolchildren from all around the world have joined together in song to help



spread a vital message about the environmental issues affecting the planet.

Conservation education experts from Chester Zoo inspired the specially written song, which has been created to raise awareness about sustainability and how reusing, recycling and reducing resources we use every day can impact the natural world. The 200 schools involved - from the UK, Europe, China, Egypt and Dubai - all joined forces to give a special online performance of the song, live to a global online audience via Zoom.

The global event was conducted by AmaSing Arts, a charity that helps develop the wellbeing, confidence and self-esteem of children through the arts. AmaSing has been working with conservationists at the zoo for several years to help inspire young people to protect the world around them.

Anya Moon, Conservation Education and Engagement Manager at Chester Zoo, said: "Educating young people on the importance of sustainability is absolutely crucial. By teaching the younger generation how the resources we use every day, like water, wood, plastic and electricity impacts our environment, they'll then go on to help shape a better future for our planet."

"We all have a part to play in making the world a better place and the climate crisis is directly linked to sustainability. For young people to be aware, educated and well informed about these topics empowers them to make a positive difference and contribute to a more sustainable future."

"Drumming up more awareness and understanding around sustainability is a key focus for Chester Zoo. Everything we use on a day to day basis comes from somewhere, and there will be a cost to the environment to create it - whether that's from air or water pollution, wildlife and habitat loss, or adding to the great garbage patch in the ocean. Around two million pieces of litter are dropped in the UK every day, and to put this into perspective, it takes 450 years for a plastic bottle to decompose in the ocean.

If we don't live sustainably it won't just be the animals and plants that suffer, but our own species, too."

Pupils from 24 schools, alongside composer and Musical Director at AmaSing, Andrew Smith, joined experts from Chester Zoo online to hear about important environmental issues and the impact that waste is having on the planet. Topics including deforestation, reusing unwanted items and ways to dispose of everyday items, inspired the lyrics to the song.

A dance routine, choreographed by House of Dance, a Chester-based performing arts school was then matched with the music.

#### Rachael Borman, Director at AmaSing, added:

"We want to empower children to become good global citizens by inspiring them through song and dance. By giving them the opportunity to share their ideas for the lyrics, they really understood the importance of living sustainably to help protect the planet."

"Chester Zoo's sustainability message and ethos fitted perfectly with our 'connect' theme which is all about connecting people all over the world. Through the arts, they're encouraged to talk about how they're feeling about the world they're living in and what changes they'd like to make for the future."

## AutoReview by Tony Yates

Keeping you motoring

### SEAT Leon FR e-HYBRID



This month's review of the SEAT FR took me into parts of Yorkshire where the grass is green, and the roads are twisty. The perfect setting for the new Leon FR e-HYBRID. I think we are all pretty much feeling like we need to buy a HYBRID now and I agree, which is why the pub chatter with my friends is no longer about MPG, it's now all abwith a 6-speed DSG gearboxout how many miles did you get out of one full charge. Anyway, let's move this on.

## Power & efficiency

The Leon FR I had on test was powered by a 1.4-litre TSi petrol engine with a 6-speed DSG gearbox

all backed up by an electric motor with a Lithium-ion battery. Capacity 12.8 kWh (usable) This gives you a total power output of 204PS and 330Nm of torque. The Leon FR will also complete 0-62 mph in just 7.5 seconds and will max out at 137mph. For those of you who wish to know about the Leon green specifications; CO2 (WLTP) emissions are as little as 27g/km. Fuel economy (mpg) (WLTP) 217.3 - 235.4mpg. Electric consumption (kWh/100km)18.1-19. Electric range (WLTP) 36 - 40 miles.

## On the road

As you would expect from a SEAT, the handling is poised thanks to SEAT's ability to get the suspension setup just right. For some, the ride can be guite harsh, especially for those of vou who wanted a softer approach; although the Leon FR is a car you buy because you want it to do all things a normal hatchback can't, such as having SEAT drive profile selection options and superb sports suspension, which in turn will help improve your high-speed cornering response by keeping you firmly on the road ahead.

## Design & technology

The Leon FR also comes with a large amount of tech and extras that you wouldn't normally find in a family hatchback. Below is iust a small amount of what you can expect to find; 17" Dynamic bi-spoke alloy wheels with 225/45 R17 91W tyres, Electrically-adjusted and heated door mirrors with fold function. LED Headlights with dynamic turn signals and high beam assist, Rain sensing wipers, Daytime running light with automatic headlight control and Coming Home feature, Wireless phone charger, Leather flat bottomed, perforated steering (with red stitching and FR logo)

and, leather gearstick, Front centre armrest, Front seats manual lumbar adjustment, Rear seat armrest, Auto-dimming rearview mirror, Illuminated front door sill, Three-zone climate control, SEAT drive profile selection and sports suspension. Space is king and the FR has a few tricks up its sleeve like the 270 litres of load capacity which offers a large family excellent versatility. With the rear seat backs folded, the boot capacity then rises to 1.191 litres.



## To sum up

As with all SEAT's, there will be very little to go wrong as reliability, in general, is very good. Also, SEAT is part of the VW Group, so you can expect build quality to be good. A fast and fully loaded family hatchback. 5 stars SEAT.

## PCC pledges £100,000 for crime prevention

All bids must be match-funded to provide maximum benefit to local communities. With match-funding, up to £200,000 could be invested into crime prevention in Cheshire over the next 12 months.







## Above and beyond

Within the pages of Chester Rambling and Hill Walking Club's summer programme is a host of enticing walks of all grades, heading in every direction out of Chester. Our leaders have made the most of limited opportunities over the past year to create walks in slightly less familiar areas, alongside the tried and tested ones that we know and cherish.

As leaders ourselves, my other half and I relish the challenge of finding new routes to offer for Club members. With group walks vetoed for much of last summer, we took the opportunity to explore by ourselves some of the lesser known hills of North Wales. One that we put together is a very varied B grade walk, starting at Llandudno's North Shore, close to the Little Orme, and heading inland towards the twin humps of Mynydd Pant and Nant y Gamar. Over a couple of reconnoitring trips, we discovered that the best views across the bay were gained by staying on the open footpath to the north side of Nant y Gamar's summit, rather than the narrower path through the trees to the top. By chance, we found a beautiful spot overlooking the town, the sea and the Great Orme, at the perfect time for a coffee break! Skirting the limestone cliffs just below the summit, the footpath then took us through woodlands

towards St David's College, housed in the historic Gloddaeth Hall. Ignoring the more well-used paths towards Penrhynside, our route took us in a southerly direction. From this footpath the outline of Snowdonia's Carneddau Ridge could be seen in the distance. In the opposite direction, we got our best view of the ancient Gloddaeth Hall itself, which had up to that point been concealed behind trees. Onwards towards Marl Hall Woods, a pleasant nature reserve managed by the Woodland Trust. Out of the blue, the undulating path opened out to reveal a limestone plateau overlooking the Conwy Valley. Below us, the river snaked its way from the Snowdonian moorlands on its downward journey towards to the sea, and opposite, we could pick out the imposing structure of Conwy Castle. With this view, we realised we'd found the perfect place for our lunch break!

This being roughly our halfway point, we changed direction to head back towards Llandudno by a different track, passing the prominent obelisk that dominates the hilltop above Llandudno Junction. From the OS map, we'd picked out a route taking in the neighbouring nature reserve at Bryn Pydew to get, in a roundabout way, to Mynydd Pant. This being our last little climb of the day, we gave ourselves a 5-minute break before descending back down to our parked car.

Many of the surroundings on this 9-mile walk had been unfamiliar to us, and some of the signage not obvious, so it took a couple of try-outs and a few questions to friendly local people before we were confident of our route! We plan one last return trip to refresh the route in our minds prior to leading it for Club members in July.
